Nebraska Division of the IAI: Scholarship Opportunity

Every year since 2004 the Nebraska IAI has offered a \$500 scholarship to one member for attendance to the Annual IAI International Educational Conference. This scholarship is named for Harold W. Moon. Moon was one of the foremost Document Examiners in the Midwest and was instrumental in forming the Nebraska Chapter of the IAI. When the Nebraska Chapter of the IAI was chartered on June 14, 1985, he served as the first elected president. This year is no different.

To qualify for the Harold Moon Scholarship you must:

- Attend the 2019 International Association for Identification Annual Educational Conference;
- Be an Active Member of the Nebraska Division of the IAI;
- Be a Forensics Practitioner (ie. Crime Scene Technician, Forensic Scientist, Officer, etc);
- Complete an application form and essay stating your personal or departmental training needs
- Upon your return from the IAI conference, provide a written synopsis to the NEIAI Board regarding training that you received, overall experience, etc.
